Budock Parish Council – www.budockparish.net

Budock Parish Council normally meets the last Monday of the month at either Budock Village Hall or Treverva Village Hall. There is always a period at the start of each meeting for comments from the public on items on the agenda. Agendas and Minutes are posted on the Treverva Village Hall notice board. Details of meetings and Minutes can be found on the website. The website has a great deal of information about the local area and how to contact the Parish Council.

Items from Parish Council

Broadband speed: Treverva and Lamanva are still not connected to the High Speed Network despite being surrounded by areas with High Speed and the Constantine exchange being upgraded last year.

Salt Bins: The yellow bins in Treverva and Lamanva are now the responsibility of the Parish Council. They are provided for the safety of pedestrians and only a small quantity (a handful) is needed to treat several square metres. After the last major Icing occurrence in 2011, when the whole bin was emptied in 24 hours, a system of control will be put in place.

Planning: The Council is very concerned about the huge numbers of houses, planned to be built in the Hillhead area and to the south of Bickland Water Road. These will be in our Parish but part of Falmouth's expansion
