The Library Service for Cornwall is being 'reviewed' yet again and has to save £1.8 million over 2 years. Anyone who has a stake in the service (**all of us!**) can make their views heard, particularly about options other than the 2 that Cornwall Council are offering. Ideas to streamline the service (such as co-locating the One Stop Shops and libraries at supermarkets for example) are welcome.
