Parish Council News

As winter approaches the salt bins will be replenished. Whilst it could be as mild as last year, ice may still be a problem. The salt is for the safety of pedestrians on paths and not for highways or private drives. The salt in the bins has to last the winter and should be used sparingly. A handful will treat several square metres.

As mentioned previously, two sacks of daffodil bulbs were generously provided by a local grower to brighten up the Parish. These have now been distributed and should provide a welcome brightness to herald spring.

Though still at risk, the mobile Library will continue to stop at Treverva every 4 weeks from 19th November stopping 0945 to 1005 next to phone box. As we are in a period of budget cuts any service that is not used will be scrutinised. Next two visits are due 17th Dec 2014 and 14th Jan 2015. Use it or lose it!
