Afterwards, thanks to some beautiful April weather, there was a BBQ in the field and games for the children. Again, much was learnt by the committee and hopefully will be built upon for next year.

Coming up soon we have the village Fun Day on 11th June, which will also incorporate a free Tea for children to celebrate the Queen's 90th Birthday. All are welcome and not just the children of the village! In the last few months the committee has also absorbed the Village Carnival committee and so we have that to organise with a date of Saturday 3rd September in the book and Falmouh Marine Band at the ready!

The committee is currently in the process of preparing an exciting plan to improve the fabric of the Playing Field which we hope to be able to present to the village and wider community within the next couple of months, thus enabling us to up our fundraising including applying for grants.
