PARISH COUNCILLOR VACANCY

Budock Parish Council currently has one vacancy on the Council.

In accordance with Rule 8 of the Local Elections (Parishes and Communities) Rules 1986 the Parish Council will be filling the vacant seat by co-option.

A person applying for co-option onto the Council must be legally qualified to hold such office. They must be willing to serve and satisfy at least one of the following qualification categories:-

- be registered as a local government elector for the parish;
- has during the whole of the preceding twelve months occupied as owner or tenant, any land or premises in the parish;
- his/her principal or only place of work during the preceding twelve months has been in the parish;
- has during the whole of the preceding twelve months resided in the parish or within 4.8 km thereof.
